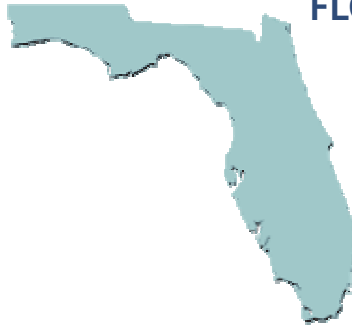

FLORIDA HIGHLIGHTS



Enrollment Data (OCTAE 2012-13)

- Secondary: 287,649
- Postsecondary: 105,893
- Adult: 53,689

- 92% of Career Pathways (CP) high school students graduate
- 87% met performance goals for mathematic skills
- 70% of CP post-secondary students remained enrolled/ transferred to another post-secondary institution
- 62% of CP adult students achieved an industry recognized credential, certificate or degree (OCTAE 2012-13 Florida Fact Sheet)

RCCPC HIGHLIGHTS

ONE ARTICULATION ALONE CAN SAVE STUDENTS \$3,011 TOWARD COLLEGE

- 87 active articulation agreements between five school districts & IRSC Adult Education
- For every \$1 invested, students saved \$5.37 toward college education
- Created 1st RCCPC website (Avg. 3,500 hits per year)
- Created video contest "Why I Need A Career Pathway?"
 - Over 700 students voted via social media
 - 1st place winner was from Clark Advanced Learning Center
- The RCCPC has sponsored "The Quest" summer youth program designed to provide high school students with the exploration of career clusters
 - 62 students participated since 2013
 - Over \$5,000 in scholarships awarded to participants
 - 95% students stated this program helped them chose a pathway
 - 89% of students will pursue a career academy
